Donseed's €1.2m investment

Kerry-based company Donseed announced an investment of €1.2 million last week, which will lead to the creation of 26 new jobs over the next two years. The new jobs will include research and development roles, technical support and sales staff at the Tralee-based firm.

The investment was supported by Enterprise Ireland and €500,000 venture capital funding from the AIB Seed Capital Fund. Donseed's web-based technology helps companies to monitor attendance, health and safety and project management. The company concentrates on the construction, retail and energy sectors and is currently working with construction companies on more than 100 sites across Ireland and Britain. Donseed plans to expand into international markets, with a particular focus on the Middle East and the US.
